

Botphoto.com Website Terms of Use

What is "acceptable use"?

Text and images on this website are provided "as is" primarily for educational use and information.

Users may borrow textual information for use in their projects, provided that they cite the source (i.e., this website). The url can be given simply as www.botphoto.com.

Users may borrow photographic images for use in their projects, utilizing them "as is", provided that they cite the source (i.e., this website), and that the project does not involve financial gain.

Users may send via email a copy of one of the images found on botphoto.com to a friend or colleague, provided that the images are not modified in any way and that the botphoto.com url be indicated, as noted above. Alternatively, one may simply provide to the friend or colleague the url of the relevant page on botphoto.com where the image is located

"As is" means that the images are not modified or altered in any way: neither cropped, nor resized, nor altered in color, nor superimposed with additional text. Additionally, users may not remove the watermark which contains my name and website address.

If your project requires that one or more of these images be customized by me, then we will need to discuss before they can be used. For example, if someone needs one of these images for a book that he/she is publishing, and the image must be set to a designated size, or the resolution be set to a designated resolution, there will be a fee charged for use of the image. In such cases, a license agreement will also need to be signed by you.

A fee is also required for use of these photographic images when fund raising or creating promotional materials, regardless of the nature of the given organization. In other words, this requirement applies to governmental, non-profit, educational or conservation organizations. In such cases, a license agreement will also need to be signed by you.

At this time use of photographic images, found on botphoto.com, for publication of electronic books is not permitted, even if the organization is non-profit, educational or conservation.

Users may not distribute these photographic images to other websites, or use them in so-called "social media" websites. In such cases, it is preferred that the user will place a link in their web page to the relevant page on botphoto.com where the image is located.

Photographic image fees are reduced when larger numbers of images are requested.
